



ADMIRE is an Erasmus+ project that aims to develop a Migrant Integration Expert Curriculum for adult educators, migrant support workers and members of migrant communities in order to promote empowerment, participation and active citizenship of all migrants.

Aims and Objectives

The main objective of ADMIRE is the design, test and implement a new Migrant Integration Expert Curriculum and digital tools for those working in adult and community education settings and existing migrant support staff to address key gaps that impact new immigrants such as: lack of knowledge on the political system of their host country; network gap between immigrant communities and local communities; and political socialization and voter motivation.

Why ADMIRE?

Successful integration of these migrant communities into civic and political life is essential if a cohesive and inclusive society in Europe is to be achieved.

ADMIRE is an Erasmus+ project coordinated by the University of Peloponnese in Greece, with the collaboration of five other partners from Cyprus, France, Ireland, Italy and Spain.
